



#### Emergency Financial Aid Funding Disclosure

Date of distribution for the below qualified students: 8/26/2020

- A student that is on a LOA due to COVID 19 between 3/17/2020 and 8/26/2020 is eligible under the following conditions
- Student must return from LOA on or before 8/26/2020
- Student must be an actively enrolled and attending 8/26/2020 unless graduated prior
- A student enrolled in a Title IV Eligible Program (min. hours 300)
- A student in good standing (meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress)

A student that is on Probation (failing SAP) is eligible under the following conditions:

- A student that was actively enrolled/attending during the institution's disruption on March 17, 2020 due to COVID 19
- A student enrolled in a Title IV Eligible Program (min. hours 300)
- A student in good standing (meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress) by 8/26/2020

A student that does NOT qualify for HEERF are defined as follows:

- A student that was NOT actively enrolled/attending during the institution's disruption on March 17, 2020 due to COVID 19
- A student NOT enrolled in a Title IV Eligible Program (min. hours 300)
- A student NOT in good standing (meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress) by 8/26/2020\*

\*\* Student has one opportunity to make SAP month of September to receive disbursement 10/2/2020. If SAP not met, they will NOT be eligible for grant.
